Please refer to the notes that you took during our conversation. Below is a summary of our discussion.

You have shown a clear progression throughout the course and worked well. It's evident that you have learnt plenty and this course has opened your eyes to the possibilities of photography. It's great that you have embraced your learning and applied yourself to be creative and take risks. I think that this first module has prepared you for your continuing studies. Your enthusiasm and focus is really encouraging and bodes well for the future.

You have taken a different approach to the final assignment. The collage is an interesting direction to take at this stage. This demonstrates your keenness to push yourself and I think that your attempt to work on something a little alternative is really positive. As we discussed the final outcome has a different narrative to your intentions but as acknowledged production often takes us elsewhere. You reflect upon this and as stated by the brief your images follow and evidences your photographic process.

Adjust your blog as we discussed making your research, particularly into photographers clearer so that they it can be easily accessed by the assessment team. Also, re work your assignment 5 reflective notes, expand a little upon your methodology and outcome, apply a little more personal analysis. It's a personal project of your choice, so include more personal motivation and honest evaluation.

As discussed consider your presentation of final work for assessment. Keep it coherent and simple at this point. Prints will suffice with white borders. Place prints

in archival acetate sleeves and then all assignments into a professional clam shell box. Please see the links below for some ideas. It's great that you are also providing a cover statement and instructions for your blog/learning log. Keep it positive with honest reflection briefly explaining your journey and outcomes and future plans. The letter you dictated is appropriate.

I think that you have shown good input within this module. Of course as you develop and proceed through the next courses your contextual and research input will be expected to become more critical and in-depth but I think that this is a challenge you will embrace.
